- 1. Call to Order: The 2021 SFCC Annual Meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. Attendees: Emmanuel Solis, Janet Castaneda, Lee Sargent, John Haro, Kurt Howeler, Nate Kessler, Anne Drebin and several other residents.
- Review of SFCC Board. Lee did a quick review of the organizational structure and roles of the board and committees. He also ran thru the 2021 achievements, along with a summary of the block reps and SFCC website.
- 3. **Treasurer's Report:** John presented the treasurer report annual summary. The trustees presented their signed statement that they've reviewed the accounts and all is in order.
- **4.** Land Use. Emmanuel gave an update on a number of projects happening in our area: BTC, the Overlake area in general, new Microsoft campus, Silver Cloud homeless shelter, Modera Overlake Apartments, Pixel Apartments, NE 24th Office Building and Seritage.
- **5. SFCC Division Covenants.** Lee did a brief summary of the efforts of a couple residents to prevent 2-story houses in divisions where the covenants haven't already been violated.
- **6. Trees.** There was a recap of the number of trees that are being removed in Sherwood Forest and the frustration that the City hasn't done more to help preserve them. The City has a goal to achieve 40% tree canopy. Currently the canopy is at about 35%. There is hope the City will put some restrictions in place over the next couple years.
- **7. Community Connections.** Anne gave a recap of the new Community Connections committee and ran thru some possible activities for next year.
- **8. Block Watch.** John talked about security in the area. He gave a rundown on a North Sector Roundtable the City hosted earlier in October. It seems our area is finally on the City's radar and we are hearing more about plans and issues than in the past. He also gave a quick talk on the Silver Cloud homeless shelter.
- 9. **Emergency Preparedness (EP):** There was a recap of the EP committee activities and the strides they made during the year.
