SFCC co-president Charlie Margolis is our newest CERT member (CERT is a FEMA certification for community emergency preparedness). Joseph Joy (SFCC secretary) is part of the Bellevue CERT board of directors helping shape the organization. **We encourage more of the Sherwood Forest community to take the basic CERT class**. This year's class is over seven consecutive Tuesday evenings, 6:00 to 9:00 PM, September 10th to October 22nd, followed by a final drill and graduation on Saturday October 26th, 7:45am until Noon.
